

## **Resolution #37 - Seminary Stewardship Education**

**Subject: Seminary Stewardship Education**

**From: Stewardship Ministry Group**

**WHEREAS**, previous synods have affirmed the importance of stewardship education for persons studying for the ordained ministry;

**WHEREAS**, pastors have expressed a desire for more specific stewardship education and preparation during the seminary process; and

**WHEREAS**, in recent curriculum changes Moravian Theological Seminary has begun to include some additional stewardship education options within the framework of other courses; therefore, be it

**RESOLVED, That** the Synod of 2006 expresses appreciation for the efforts of Moravian Theological Seminary to strengthen stewardship education for seminary students;

**RESOLVED, That** during the intersynodal period of 2006-2010 the Provincial Elders' Conference of the Southern Province shall work with Moravian Theological Seminary to develop a specific stewardship education course of study which shall become a requirement for candidates for the ordained ministry in the Southern Province; and

**RESOLVED, That** the Provincial Elders' Conference shall provide to the Synod of 2010 a report on the progress of its work with Moravian Theological Seminary to provide this course of study.
